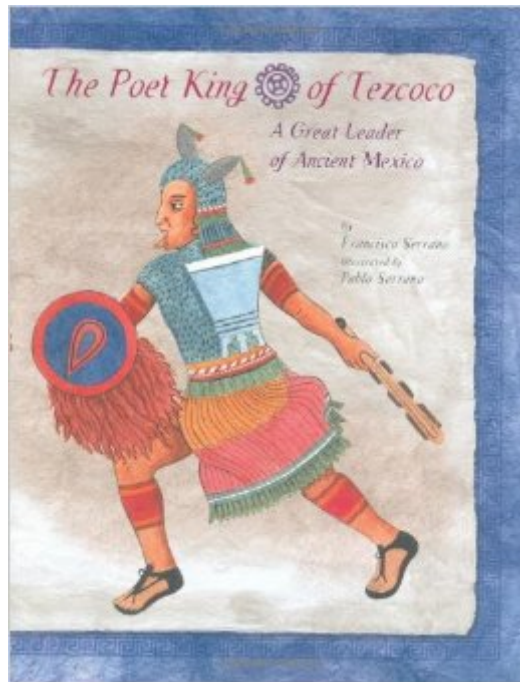


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# The Poet King Of Tezcoco: A Great Leader Of Ancient Mexico
